- 1. Confirm there are mounting holes in Transfer Case Skid (fig. 1). There were a limited number of Bison produced without these holes.
 - a. If there are no holes, use templates (AEV30313 & AEV30314) to drill holes.
 - b. Prep with Rust Preventive



2. Remove and SAVE the 2 M10 Bolts from the oil pan skid (fig. 2)



- 3. Slide Bracket under the oil pan skid (fig. 3).
 - a. Reinstall 2 M10 bolts loose through both pieces.
 - b. Slide the supplied flag nut into the frame and install supplied M10 bolt. Leave loose at this time.



- 4. Starting on the driver side install the first 3 tubes loosely using 5 M10 carriage bolts with nuts (fig. 4).
 - NOTE: On Diesel models, the tubes can only be installed in one direction.
 - a. Be sure to put the "Y" tube over the other tubes.
 - b. Fully tighten hardware.
- 5. Continue installing one tube at a time working toward the passenger side. Fully tighten bolts as you go.
- 6. Once the final tube is installed, tighten the bolts at the oil pan skid from Step 3.


