



#### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**


- 1. Remove the mesh grille and the front bumper from the front of the UTV using a T20 Torx bit. See Photo 1.
- 2. Remove the (3) lower bolts from the bumper using a 14mm socket. See Photo 2.







- 3. Remove the (2) upper bolts and nut using a 14mm socket. See Photo 3.
- 4. Swap the bracket on the voltage regulator using the OE hardware. See Photo 4.





- 5. Install the winch plate using (3) of the supplied 8mm hex bolts, (3) 8mm flat washers and (3) 8mm flang nuts. **See Photo 5.**
- 6. Install the winch onto the winch plate using the hardware supplied in the winch kit. See Photo 6.







- Install the hawse fairlead to the winch plate using the hardware supplied in the winch kit. Then insert the cable through the plate. See Photo 7.
- 8. Connect the winch wiring to the UTV's power supply.
- 9. Install the bumper onto the UTV, secure the bumper using the OE hardware. See Photo 8.





- 10. Secure the front of the winch plate to the bumper, use the OE bolts in the bottom (2) holes. Secure the upper bolt holes using (2) of the supplied 8mm hex bolts, (4) 8mm flat washers and (2) hex nuts. Tighten using 13mm sockets and wrench. See Photo 9.
- 11. Install the OE mesh grille using the OE hardware. See Photo 10.
- 12. Tighten the bumper bolts using a 13mm wrench and socket.
